# Annual Wilton Rooster Crow Rules and Regulations

1. The Rooster must be healthy
2. Entry Fee is \$5.00 per rooster and is payable in advance to Crow Master Judy Davies.
3. Each Rooster must be in a covered cage. One rooster per cage.
4. Each Rooster will have a sign with the Rooster's name and breed.
5. Tables for the cages are optional, but must be set up by the owner no later than 8:45 am

## The Crow

1. Roosters will be in covered cages.
2. There will be one owner or handler for each rooster.
3. There will be one judge assigned to each rooster.
4. Audience silence will be maintained at the beginning of the Crow.
5. The Crowmaster will decide the resolution of any disputes.
6. At the Timekeeper's signal, cage covers are removed and the contest begins.
7. Roosters are encouraged to crow, but are not to be touched.
8. The contest will last for 20 minutes. Judges will tally each crow and the Rooster who crows the most times will be declared the Champion.
9. No hens allowed in the area during the Crow.
10. Awards will be made after all crows are tallied, and the winners announced. Awards for Best-Decorated Cage within the theme of Farmers Bureau and Best Looking Rooster will be decided by the popular vote. Voting is by audience, owners and helpers.

## Awards

First Place will receive A Ribbon, and \$50.00

Second Place will receive a ribbon and \$25.00

All other entrants will receive participation ribbons and all entrants will be given a sample of chicken feed.

## Time

Welcoming remarks from the Crow Master start at 9am. The kids will do a 5 minute crow contest to get the roosters ready. The crow starts shortly after. Please have your rooster(s) at the Dillard School by 8:30 am. Roosters must be in place by 8:45 am or be disqualified.
